

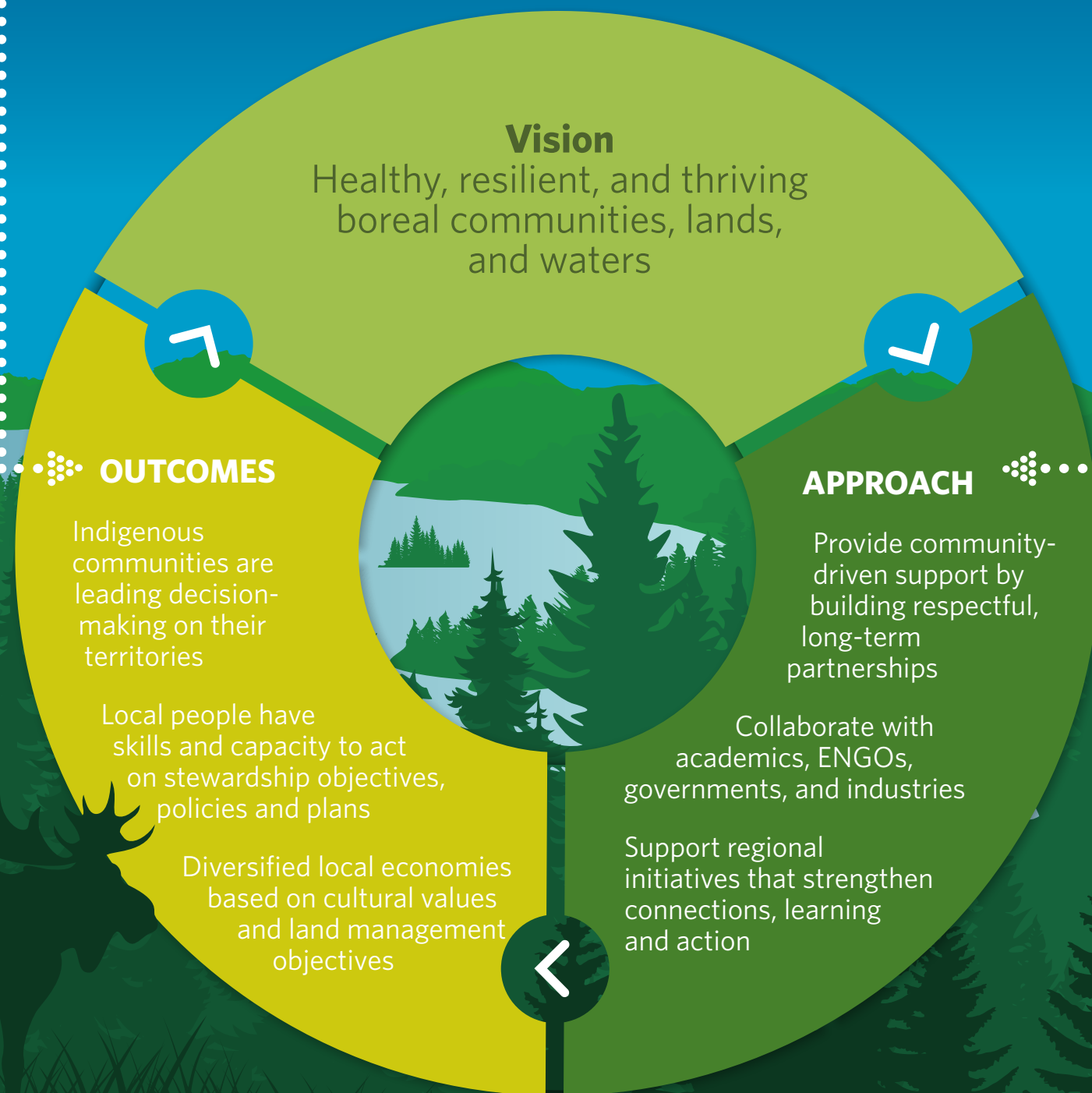


Supporting Indigenous-Led Conservation in Boreal Manitoba
